As we approach the new Academic year 2012-13, please note the following:

- 1. ADMISSION PROGRAMME 2012-13:** As per the School policy, siblings of students already on our rolls are given priority for admissions to Nursery, L.KG. & U.KG. As we anticipate a large number of requests for the limited seats available for the coming year, you are hereby requested to *register & confirm your child's admission to Nursery, L.KG. & U.KG on 5th Jan 2012 on priority*. Kindly note that we shall also start accepting the admissions from other interested parents from 5th Jan 2012 and therefore, cannot guarantee admissions against delayed registrations.
- 2. NEW UNIFORMS:** Reference to our previous circular dated 21st Sept 2011. As already intimated, we are introducing the '**new look**' School uniform, complete with all accessories, w.e.f April 2012, for all grades initiating from KG in April, 2012 and gradually by the end of September, 2012 covering entirely the Primary, Secondary & Higher Secondary Sections. The new attire comes with carefully selected clothing material and in attractive designs, even while ensuring comfort and economy. The detailed schedule of the uniform & accessory supplies that would be distributed exclusively through the School store shall be intimated to you separately.
- 3. SCHOOL PROGRAMME INNOVATIONS:** The School has finalized plans to continue with innovative processes and effective teaching – learning methodologies aimed at enhancing the learning outcomes of our students at all levels.
 - **IMPLEMENTATION OF INTERACTIVE SMART BOARDS** from Grade VI upwards with regularly updated software content of **Edurite Digitally** - an interactive teaching tool licensed by Pearson Education, the global leader in Educational services – to cater effectively to the diverse learning needs of all our students across KG-12, making learning an experience for a life time.
 - **'WORDS WORTH':**- Facilitates all round language skill development of the student through the use of modern technology. The content has rich audio-visual features based on the natural learning approach. It aims at improving all aspects of English language, besides offering remedy to correct regional influences of the mother tongue.

- **ROBOTICS:** A well structured, age appropriate programme offered by 'THINK LABS', under the aegis of IIT-Bombay - designed to develop a deeper understanding of the principles of Science and its application as technology. Here our students will not only learn to use technology but also receive the competence to create technology.
- **XSEED:** Expanding the experiential learning approach of XSEED curriculum from M/s Idiscoveri Education upto Grade VI. Xseed is a comprehensive curricular program based on experiential and research based methods to ensure that all children understand concepts better. It is highly relevant in the context of changing patterns of board exams, new requirements at work places in the fast emerging society. The program is an endeavor to help children develop a strong foundation in the primary years, critical for a child's development.
- **EDUSPORTS:** Structured, inclusive Sports curriculum 'SOAR' licensed by Edusports, India., aimed at a structured sports curriculum in schools with a strong emphasis on Physical Education, which will go on to benefit the overall performance of the child from KG.
- **VISUAL MEDIA:** Hugely enriching Emotional Intelligence content delivered through interactive multimedia tools.
- **LEARNOMETER** assessments upto Grade V and **ASSET** evaluation from Grade VI to VIII.
- **TRAINING:** Ongoing Faculty training & development programmes conducted by Resource persons from India that ensures effective implementation of programmes.

4. **FEE REVISION:** The School has embarked on various academic programmes and infrastructural upgradations during the past years involving heavy capital outlays and recurring expenses. Moreover, yearly escalation in building rent and periodic hikes in teacher emoluments have compelled the School for a reasonable Fee revision with effect from Academic year 2012-13.

Quarterly Fee: The School shall be implementing Term wise Tuition fee collection w.e.f academic year 2012-13. The Annual tuition fee shall be payable in four quarterly installments, as per the given schedule.

Transport Fee: The transportation fee for the academic year 2012-13 will be SR. 480/- per term (3 Months) which has to be paid along with the Quarterly Tuition Fee. One way facility will be charged @ SR. 375/- per term (3 months).

5. **THIRD LANGUAGE:** In order to ensure compliance with CBSE bylaws, there will be no teaching of Third Language in the school for Class I & II students from the academic year 2012-13 onwards. Implementation/teaching of third language will be from Std-III upwards.


6. **LONG LEAVE REQUEST:** As per the CBSE bylaws the Principal is authorized to grant leave (i.e. only in case of medical emergencies or exigencies) for a maximum of 30 days in total. The bylaw also states that each student should have a minimum of 85% attendance (mandatory) to give his/her Final/Annual Exam. Parents are advised not to request for long leave.
7. **LONG LEAVE REQUEST:** Under no circumstances retest will be taken.

We are pleased to inform you that to keep pace with the growing stature of our School, the Management is also planning to institute Scholarships / Proficiency awards for outstanding student performance in Academics and Co-scholastic activities.
